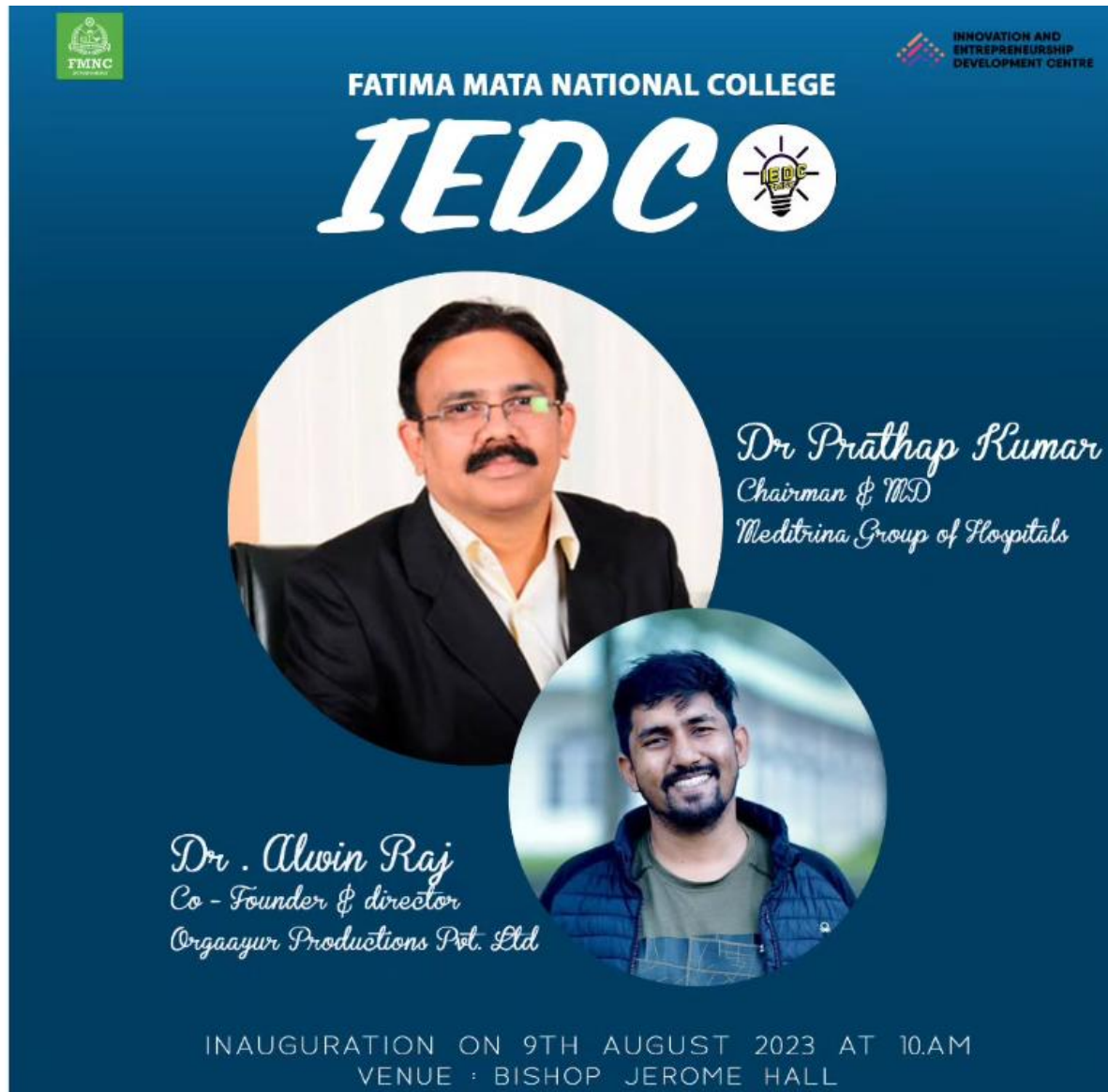




- **IEDC LAUNCH EVENT**

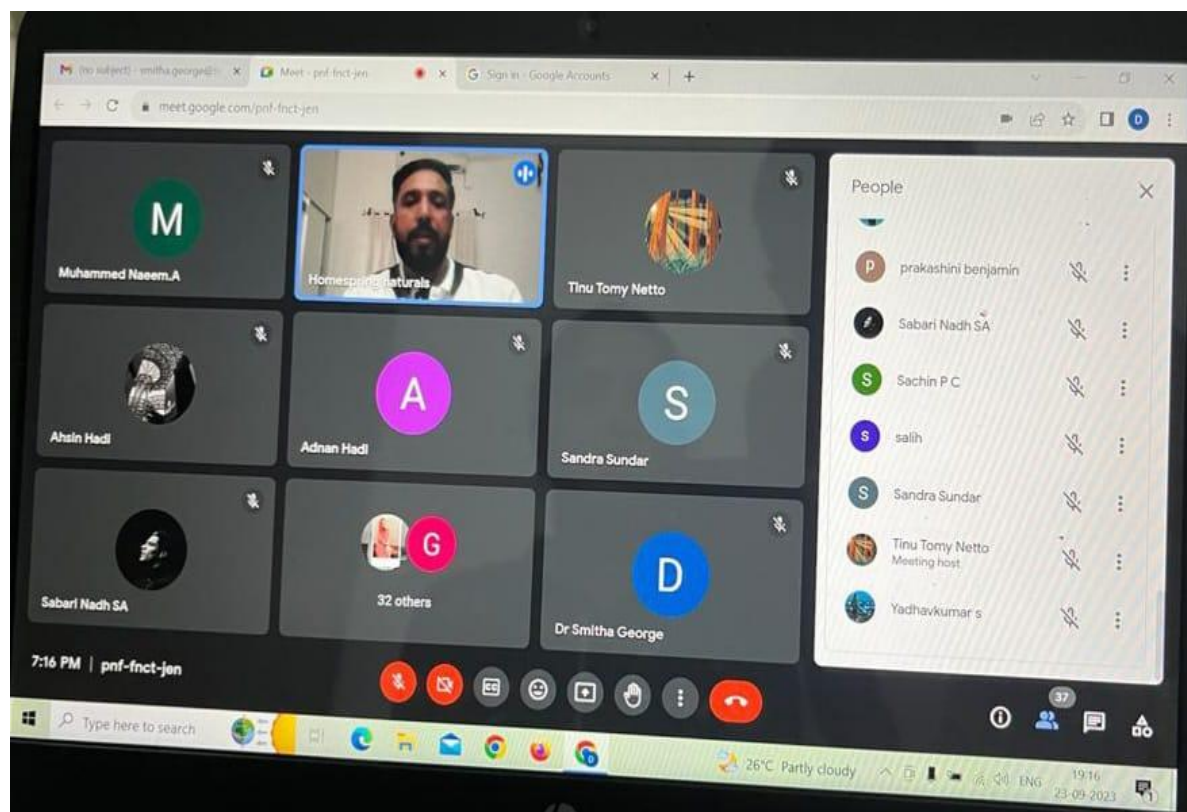
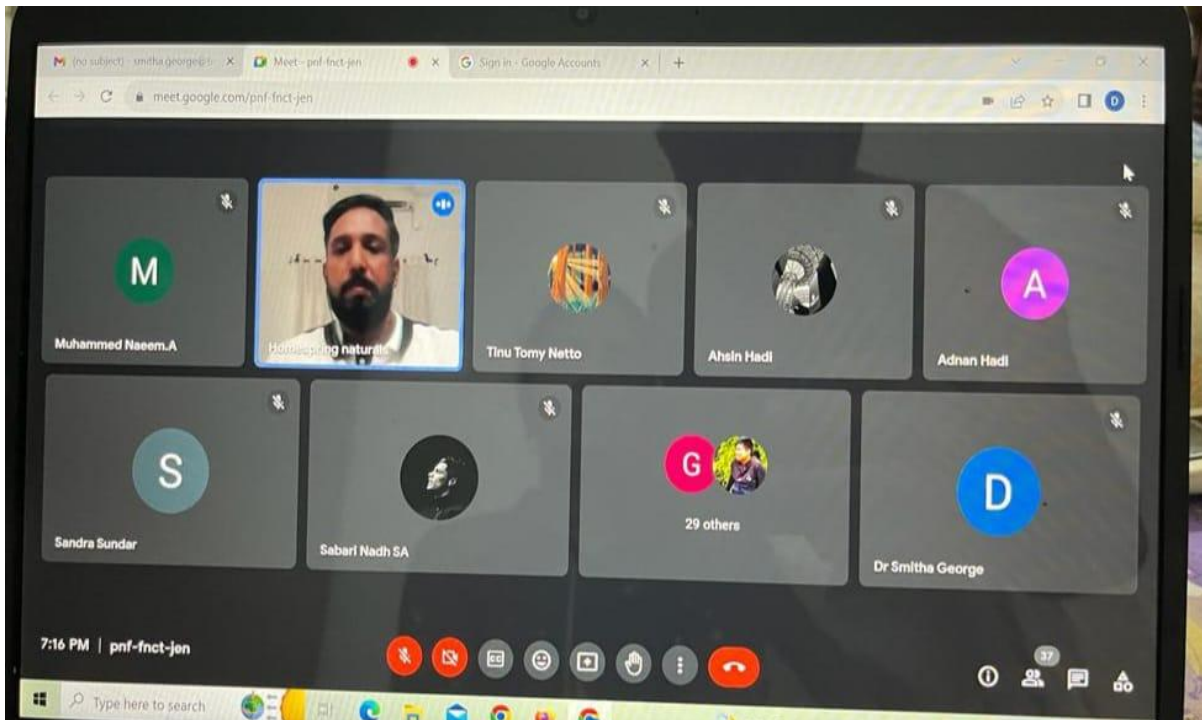
- **FAILURE FRIDAY**

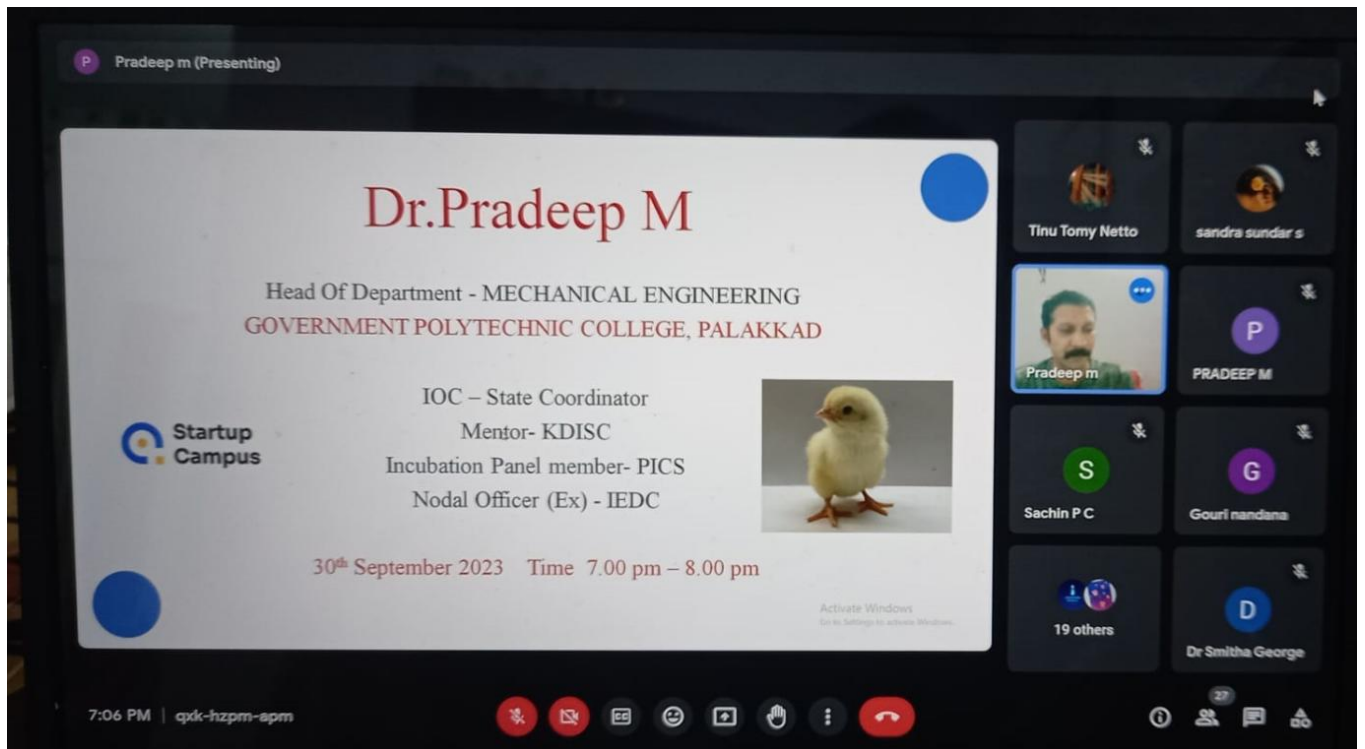

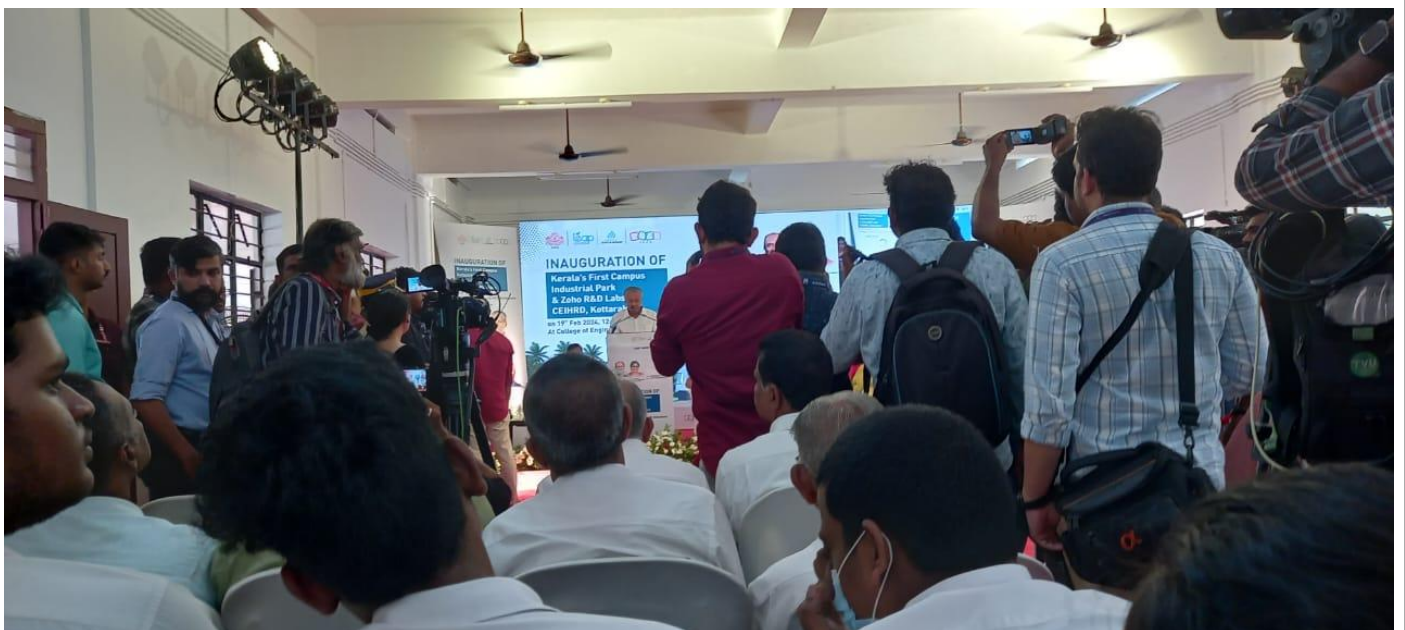
